Meals will be provided through Taft Elementary. Summer program dates will be as follows: June 2nd - July 30. We will not serve meals the week preceding July 4th, June 28-July 2. The menu is written below, and is subject to change at any time.

For those eating in person: breakfast will be provided from 7:45am to 8:30am, lunch will be provided from 11:30am to 12:15pm. There is no sign up required.

Meal pick up will be located at the front entry of Taft Elementary from 7am to 8:30am. You will receive breakfast and lunch for the day.

Twin Rivers Elementary will have meals available for pick up at the front entrance from 8:00-9:00am
Mease Elementary will have meals available from 9:00-9:30am at the front entrance
